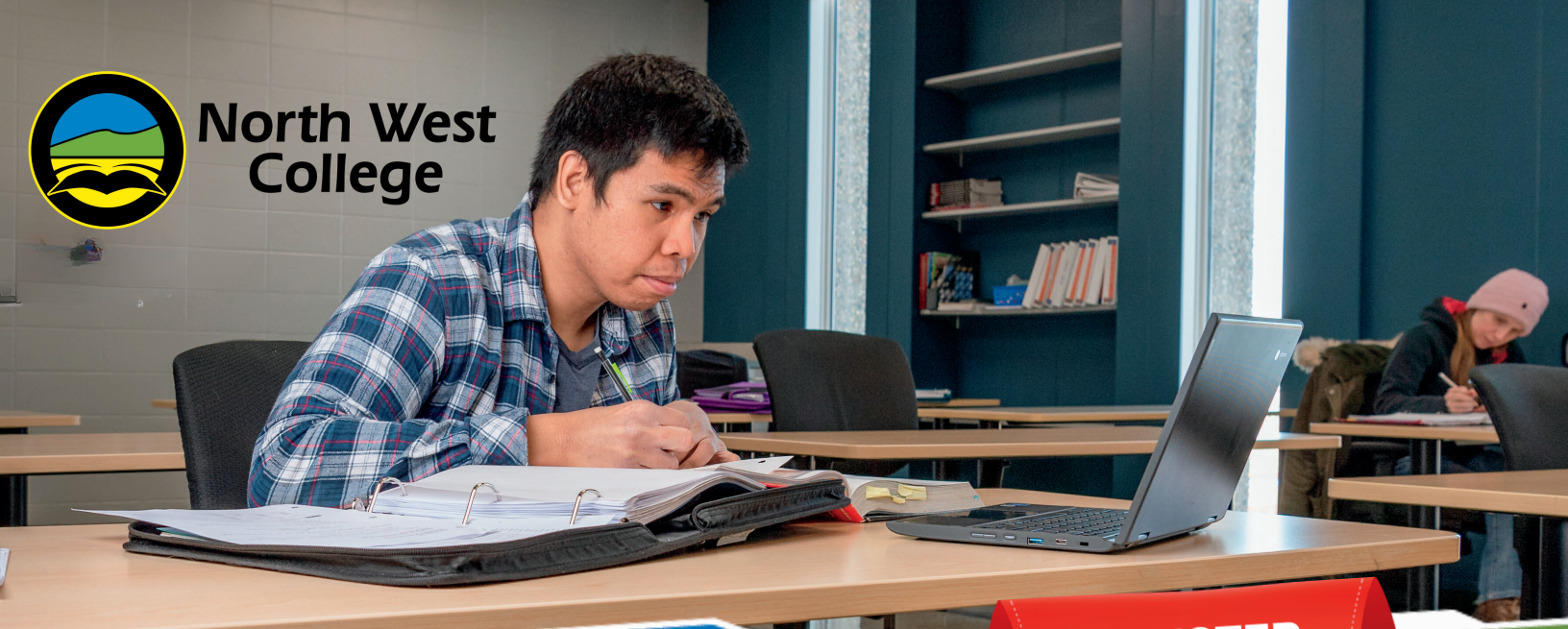

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This credit program will provide adult learners with a foundation in Math, English and other skills needed to transition into an Adult 12 program.

The program helps adults improve their literacy and essential skills. The knowledge, skills and attitudes gained in ABE Adult 10 are needed for those who wish to further their education in an Adult 12 program, enter or re-enter the labour force, who need further training or who wish to advance in a chosen career. Two Grade 12 Electives are included in this program as well as a 60 - 80 hour work experience.
