Reporting directly to the Wellness Counselling Supervisor, the Wellness Counsellor will provide counselling support for clients seeking mental health and addictions support. They provide referrals to specialized treatment in mental health and addictions when needed.

The Wellness Counsellor plans and delivers outcome-effective clinical case coordination and counselling, intervention prevention, advocacy, community action, program leadership and connecting clients to cultural services and resources and will possess strong interpersonal communication skills and the ability to communicate effectively with adults.

Registered Social Worker/Professional Counsellor Role and Requirements:

- Minimum Bachelor's Degree in Social Work or related disciplines; must be registered or eligible to register with professional licensing body such as SASW or FNWACCB
- Assist clients to address emotional, psychological and relationship difficulties, utilizing a range of counselling methods and models.
